PERU

Peru is the 3rd largest country in South America. Located on the shores of the Pacific Ocean between Ecuador and Chile, the country stretches across the tropics of the Southern Hemisphere into the rainforests of the Amazon where it shares a border with Colombia, Brazil and Bolivia. With the Andes splitting the land in half from North to South, Peru benefits from an exceptionally varied climate and an astounding variety of landscapes that have fostered an abundant biodiversity and many great human civilizations. Famous for being the birthplace of the Inca Empire and a major player in the Spanish colonization of the continent, it has gained the favors of travelers worldwide for its amazing cuisine, its fascinating history and its incredibly rich wilderness.



LIMA - THE CITY OF KINGS

Peru's capital Lima is one of the twenty-four regions that, together with the Constitutional Province of Callao, form the Republic of Peru. It is the most populated region and the largest city in Peru with more than 10 million inhabitants. The diversity of Limenians reflect the country's population making it a very cosmopolitan urban center. The city of Lima was founded by Spanish conquistador Francisco Pizarro on January 18, 1535, as the 'Ciudad de los Reyes' (the City of Kings). Nowadays, the city's vibrant food and cultural scenes make it a solid match to any other metropolis.

AREQUIPA - THE WHITE CITY

Located in the southwest of Peru, the region of Arequipa features a unique volcanic mountain range, the impressive Colca Canyon and the Misti Volcano towering the city of Arequipa from its 19,101-foot peak (5,825 m). The colonial city was founded in 1540 by Manuel de Carbajal, a Spanish conqueror and it is known as 'the white city' because most of the central city was built with sillar, a white volcanic rock. Arequipa is the second most populated city in Peru, sitting at 7,700 feet (2350 m) above sea level.




COLCA CANYON

The Colca Canyon is located north of Arequipa in the valley of the Colca River in southern Peru and is famous for being one of the deepest in the world 3,400 meters deep. It was once considered the deepest canyon in the world however, since then it has been shown that a nearby canyon, the Cotahuasi Canyon, is even deeper. Its highest point is 4350 m above sea level. It is a habitat of the giant Andean condor, which is observed from viewpoints such as the Cruz del Cóndor. The landscape of the canyon covers a green valley and traditional remote villages with terraced agriculture that preceded the Incas. The Colca River is popular for rafting and is a popular destination for hiking.

Arequipa is one of the most attractive colonial cities of Peru which has known how to preserve its patrimony throughout time (it has recently been classified by UNESCO as cultural patrimony of humanity). The city was founded in 1540 by Manuel Garcí de Carbajal.

The Santa Catalina Monastery is a virtual miniature city at the heart of the great city with its tiny streets bordered by small houses colored in clay, blue, and white, its plazas and fountains remind a faraway Andalucía. It was founded under the rule of King Phillip II in 1580 and is very well conserved despite the numerous earth quakes which hit Arequipa. It is a place of peace and serenity at the heart of the busy city.

Day 2: Arequipa- Colca Canyon



Private 2-day and 1-night excursion in the Colca Canyon

Arequipa - Colca

Colca is located four hours north of Arequipa. The road to the valley crosses the lower slopes of Mount Chachani and runs along plains studded with Ichu and Yareta (plants used for fuel) and which are home to alpacas and Vizcacha rodents. The road crosses a high point of 4,350 meters before dropping into the valley, an area of breathtaking landscapes surrounded by terrace and snow-capped peaks. Far below, at a depth of 3,400 meters, the Colca River winds along the bottom of the canyon, one of the world's deepest.

The valley features archaeological remains left behind by the Collagua, the ancient inhabitants of the area. These include cave paintings and grain storerooms known as colcas. There are 14 towns all along riverbanks, which were founded in the sixteenth century to settle the Collagua natives who were scattered around the area. Despite the ravages of time, the towns have preserved their original characteristics, such as the outline of their streets, their richly-decorated colonial churches and traditional festivals.

40 km from Chivay, the first of the towns along the way, stands a superb natural lookout point from where one can watch the condors wheeling over the valley, while in the distance one can spot the Coropuna and Ampato volcanoes. Several towns in the valley provide lodging, but one can also camp out and go trekking.

The condor is primarily a scavenger, feeding on carrion. It prefers large carcasses, such as those of deer or cattle. It reaches sexual maturity at five or six years of age and nests at elevations of up to 5,000 m (16,000 ft), generally on inaccessible rock ledges. One or two eggs are usually laid. It is one of the world's longest-living birds, with a lifespan of up to 50 years.

The Andean Condor is a national symbol in Peru, Argentina, Bolivia, Chile, Colombia, and Ecuador, and plays an important role in the folklore and mythology of the Andean regions.

Hotel names are mentioned for reference only. If not available, a hotel in a similar category (price and quality) will be substituted. In the same way, the type of room (double or twin) remains subject to hotel availability.

The traveler is responsible for ensuring that his passport is valid and to check if he/she needs an entry visa to the country and to check the weight of luggage allowed by the airlines (additional weight to be paid by the traveler).

PAYMENT

1. PRICE CURRENCY

All prices are stated in US dollars (USD).

2. PRICE VALIDITY

Prices are per person and based on shared twin room or double occupancy.

Prices on our website are subject to change at any time.

Prices do not include international, regional nor domestic flights.

Prices do not include credit/debit card and/or PayPal© payment commissions.

Stated prices do not include extra costs applying during national or regional holidays in the visited country(ies).

In case of human or computer error, the Travel Agency reserves the right to re-invoice for the correct price or service. If the Traveler does not agree to pay an increase due to a mistake from the Travel Agency, the Travel Agency will proceed to the cancellation and refund the Traveler entirely.

3. PAYMENT

3.1. Deposit Payment

In order to confirm his booking, the Traveler must make a 30% deposit payment on the total booking amount within 7 days of trip participation written confirmation.

If the deposit payment is not received by the Travel Agency within 7 days, the Travel Agency has the right to cancel the booking.

3.2. Balance Payment

Balance payment is due 45 days before the Traveler's arrival date to the visited country(ies).

3.3. Full Payment

Full payment (instead of deposit payment) might be requested by the Travel Agency in the following cases:

- Last-minute booking
- Depending on flights availability
- Depending on the availability of certain services suppliers such as but not limited to: luxury accommodation, cruises

3.4. Forms of Payment

The Travel Agency accepts the following payment methods: wire transfer, Visa©, MasterCard©, American Express©, Diners Club© credit cards and PayPal© payments.

Third-party credit cards are not accepted.

All payments made within 45 days of departure must be made by Visa©, MasterCard©, American Express©, Diners Club© credit/debit cards or PayPal©. Wire transfers will not be accepted for such payments.

The Traveler is responsible for all banking fees associated with wire transfer, which might not only include the fees charged by the sending bank, but also the fees of intermediary banks, through which the money travels before reaching the Travel Agency's bank account.

In case of credit card and PayPal© payments, the Travel Agency will charge an additional commission:

- 4,1% for Visa©, MasterCard©, Diners Club©, Discover©, JCB©, Diners Club, UnionPay© credit card payments
- 5,2% for American Express© credit card payments
- 7% for Paypal© payments

3.5. Late Payment

If there is any outstanding balance by the final payment due date listed on the Traveler's invoice, all travel services will be subject to cancellation. In such case, the Travel Agency will notify the Traveler who will have 3 days to confirm his choice of either:

- Processing the final payment and pay a penalty fee of 10 USD/person/day of delay
