The city of Lima was founded by Spanish conquistador Francisco Pizarro on January 18, 1535, as the 'Ciudad de los Reyes' (the City of Kings). 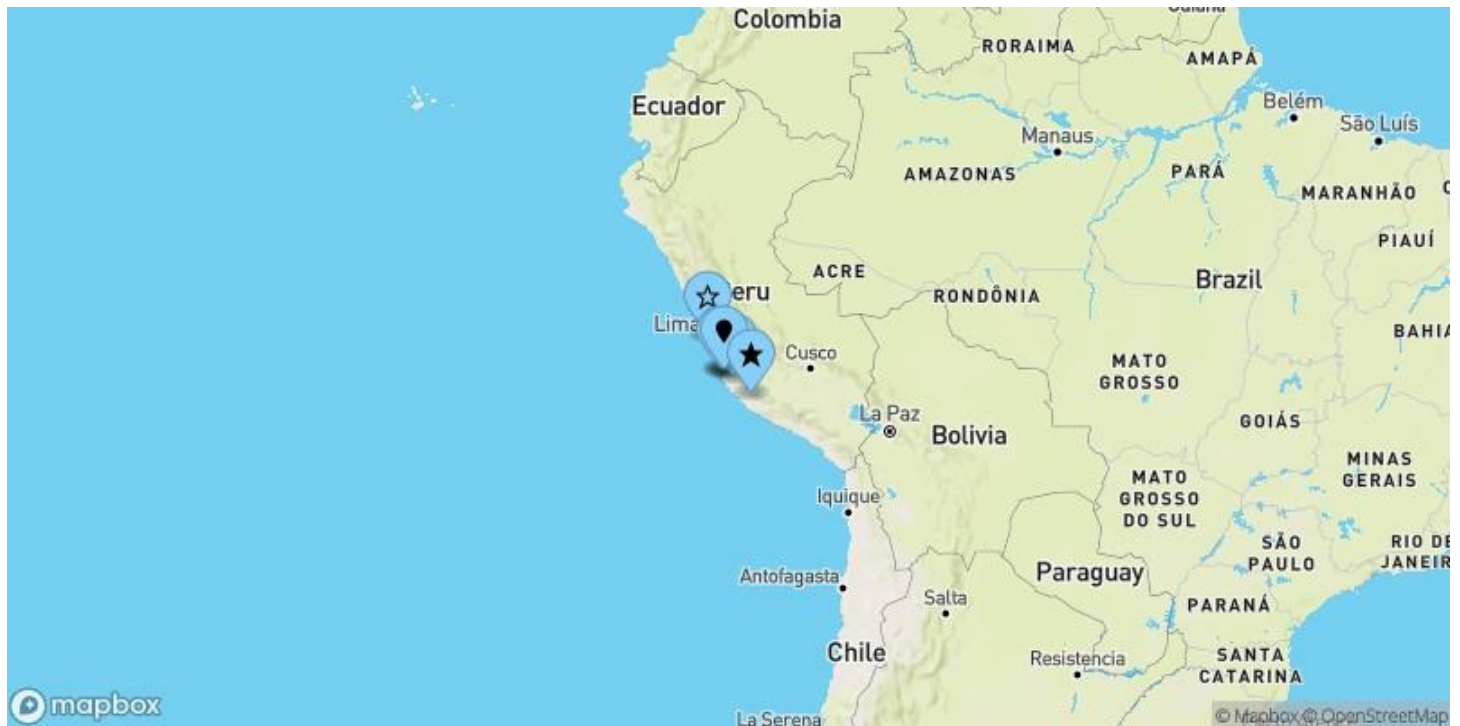


THE ENIGMATIC SOUTH

Half-day shared tour to the Ballestas Islands

Arrival at El Chaco pier to embark on the Ballestas Islands for a mini cruise of approximately 2 hours. The cruise begins at the port of Salaverry and then along the Paracas peninsula, home of the famous geoglyph candelabra. Then, the boat will circulate around the Ballestas Islands to admire the local fauna: seals, Humboldt penguins, spider crabs, biting birds and black and white neck cormorants

IN OPTION : Overflight Nazca lines from Pisco / AERODIANA
(Airport tax not included, about US\$ 10.00 p/pax to be paid on site)
(Entrance fee to the Nazca Lines not included, about US\$15.00 p/pax to be paid on site)

Transfer to the aerodrome to fly over the impressive and enigmatic Nazca lines, whose meaning or use is still unknown today.

Note: the overflight time is conditioned to weather conditions and the number of people flying that day, so patience and flexibility are the order of the day, especially between June and September, the coldest season in the southern hemisphere , where there is frequent fog until the early hours of the morning.

Depending on the weather conditions, it is possible to schedule the flight over the Nazca Lines the previous day.

Everything will be done to meet the original tour program. In the event of changes, the traveler will be informed.

The services offered by Gaston-Sacaze are those described in the program. Any service not specified in the program and / or specified as not included in our services must be paid by the traveler.

Hotel names are mentioned for reference only. If not available, a hotel in a similar category (price and quality) will be substituted. In the same way, the type of room (double or twin) remains subject to hotel availability.

The traveler is responsible for ensuring that his passport is valid and to check if he/she needs an entry visa to the country and to check the weight of luggage allowed by the airlines (additional weight to be paid by the traveler).

Exceptionally, in case of flight schedule changes and for operational, reasons, some meals may be switched or changed (e.g. packed lunch instead of a restaurant). Everything will be done to allow maximum time for discovery of the different sites.

PAYMENT

1. PRICE CURRENCY

All prices are stated in US dollars (USD).

2. PRICE VALIDITY

Prices are per person and based on shared twin room or double occupancy.

Prices on our website are subject to change at any time.

Prices do not include international, regional nor domestic flights.

Prices do not include credit/debit card and/or PayPal© payment commissions.

Stated prices do not include extra costs applying during national or regional holidays in the visited country(ies).

In case of human or computer error, the Travel Agency reserves the right to re-invoice for the correct price or service. If the Traveler does not agree to pay an increase due to a mistake from the Travel Agency, the Travel Agency will proceed to the cancellation and refund the Traveler entirely.

3. PAYMENT

3.1. Deposit Payment

In order to confirm his booking, the Traveler must make a 30% deposit payment on the total booking amount within 7 days of trip participation written confirmation.

If the deposit payment is not received by the Travel Agency within 7 days, the Travel Agency has the right to cancel the booking.

3.2. Balance Payment

Balance payment is due 45 days before the Traveler’s arrival date to the visited country(ies).

3.3. Full Payment

Full payment (instead of deposit payment) might be requested by the Travel Agency in the following cases:

- Last-minute booking
- Depending on flights availability
- Depending on the availability of certain services suppliers such as but not limited to: luxury accommodation, cruises

3.4. Forms of Payment

The Travel Agency accepts the following payment methods: wire transfer, Visa©, MasterCard©, American Express©, Diners Club© credit cards and PayPal© payments.

Third-party credit cards are not accepted.

All payments made within 45 days of departure must be made by Visa©, MasterCard©, American Express©, Diners Club© credit/debit cards or PayPal©. Wire transfers will not be accepted for such payments.

The Traveler is responsible for all banking fees associated with wire transfer, which might not only include the fees charged by the sending bank, but also the fees of intermediary banks, through which the money travels before reaching the Travel Agency’s bank account.

In case of credit card and PayPal© payments, the Travel Agency will charge an additional commission:

- 4,1% for Visa©, MasterCard©, Diners Club©, Discover©, JCB©, Diners Club, UnionPay© credit card payments
- 5,2% for American Express© credit card payments
- 7% for Paypal© payments

3.5. Late Payment

If there is any outstanding balance by the final payment due date listed on the Traveler’s invoice, all travel services will be subject to cancellation. In such case, the Travel Agency will notify the Traveler who will have 3 days to confirm his choice of either:

- Accepting the cancellation
- Processing the final payment and pay a penalty fee of 10 USD/person/day of delay
